## BoG-XXIII (2019)-1: Confirmation of the minutes of the XXII meeting of the Board of Governors of NIT Meghalaya held on 01.04.2019

The XXII meeting of the Board of Governors of the Institute was held on 01.04.2019 in the Conference room of NIT Meghalaya. The minutes of the meeting were circulated amongst the members of the Board for their comments/ observations. The comments received from MHRD dated 10.04.2019 has been incorporated in the minutes. After discussions, the Board resolved to confirm the Minutes.

BOG-XXIII (2019)-R1: The Board RESOLVED to CONFIRM the Minutes of the XXII Meeting of the Board of Governors of NIT Meghalaya held on 01<sup>st</sup> April, 2019.

## BoG-XXIII(2019)-2: ATR of the decisions of the XXII Meeting of the Board of Governors (BoG), NIT Meghalaya held on 01.04.2019.

<u>BoG-XXIII (2019)-5:</u> Implementation of Recruitment Rules for Faculty of NITs and IIEST on the basis of clarifications issued by MHRD as per recommendations of Oversight Committee

The matter for Implementation of Recruitment Rules for Faculty of NITs and IIEST- issue of clarifications as per recommendations of Oversight Committee received from the MHRD vide No.F.33-9/2011-TS.III dated 16.04.2019 was placed before the Board for adoption of the same by the Institute.

The Board discussed the Recruitment Rules for Faculty of NITs and IIEST and also noted that both NIT Division and IFD of MHRD have submitted comments to adopt these Recruitment Rules as instructed in the aforementioned letter and have advised the Institute to adhere to the instructions of the Ministry. The Chairman, BoG also noted that the Institute shall adhere to all guidelines of the Ministry while carrying out faculty recruitment.

The Board resolved to approve for adoption of the clarifications issued by the MHRD as per the recommendations of the Oversight Committee for implementation of the Recruitment Rules for Faculty of NITs and IIEST.

BoG-XXIII (2019)-R5: The Board RESOLVED to ADOPT the clarifications issued by the MHRD as per the recommendations of the Oversight Committee for implementation of the Recruitment Rules for Faculty of NITs and IIEST.

<u>BoG-XXIII (2019)-6:</u> Implementation of Recruitment Rules for Non-Teaching Staff of NITs based on recommendations of Oversight Committee

The matter for Implementation of Recruitment Rules for Non-Teaching Staff of NITs based on recommendations of Oversight Committee received from the MHRD videNo.F.35-5/2018-TS.III dated 04.04.2019 was placed before the Board for adoption of the same by the Institute.

The Board discussed the new Recruitment Rules (2019) of Non-Teaching Staff and also noted that both NIT Division and IFD of MHRD have submitted comments to adopt these Recruitment Rules as instructed in the aforementioned letter and have advised the Institute to adhere to the instructions of the Ministry. The Chairman, BoG also noted that the Institute shall adhere to all guidelines of the Ministry while carrying out recruitment of the non-teaching posts.

BoG-XXIII (2019)-R6: The Board RESOLVED to APPROVE the adoption of the Non-teaching Recruitment Rules (2019) for implementation and Institute should adhered all the guidelines given by MHRD.

## <u>BoG-XXIII (2019)-7:</u> Status of recruitment process for Faculty Members in NIT Meghalaya

The Board was apprised of the status of the recruitment process for Faculty Members. The Director informed the Board that the advertisement for faculty positions was made 25.02.2019 and the last date for submitting online was 16.04.2019 and at the time of putting the advertisement mostly vacancies were available for SC and OBC Categories. Accordingly, the same was mentioned in the Advertisement. The Board was informed that a total number of 648 applications were received and that screening of the applications by the respective Departments is in progress.

The Board noted the action taken by the Institute.

BoG-XXII (2019)-R7: The Board NOTED the ACTIONS TAKEN by the Institute.

## <u>BoG-XXIII (2019)-8:</u> Signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Shantou University, China and NIT Meghalaya

The Board was informed that the Institute intends to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Shantou University (as represented by the College of Engineering), China to establish ties between the Universities, which may lead to the establishment of partnership agreements for exchange purposes and/or academic cooperation. The Memorandum shall be subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent. It will be valid initially for a period of five years with effect from the date of signing.

The Board noted that NIT Division, MHRD had commented that the proposal may be considered under Section 8(xiii) of the amended Statutes of NITs and that prior approval of MHRD is needed for signing an agreement by NITs with any other foreign Institutions. The IFD, MHRD had further commented that the draft MoU contained details of only the area of exchange of students but no details with respect to the other areas identified for development. The Board discussed the matter and advised the Institute to first write to MHRD for obtaining prior permission for signing the Memorandum of Understanding and the Student Exchange Agreement with Shantou University (as represented by the College of engineering), China. The matter shall be once again placed before the Board for its approval after obtaining the MHRD's permission.

BoG-XXIII(2019)-R8: The Board RESOLVED to ADVISE the Institute to first write to MHRD for obtaining prior permission for signing the Memorandum of Understanding and the Student Exchange Agreement with Shantou University (as represented by the College of engineering), China and to place the matter once again before the Board for its approval after obtaining the MHRD's permission.

#### **BoG-XXIII (2019)-9:** Board Nominee to the Faculty Selection Committees

The Board was informed that as per the Statutes of the NITs, one member of each Faculty Selection Committee is a Board Nominee who is an expert in relevant field. A list of experts was placed before the Board for its approval.

After discussion, the Board approved the list of experts as Board's Nominees to the various Faculty Selection Committees. The Board also noted the comments of the IFD, MHRD which stated that the nominees proposed should be clear from vigilance angle. The Director was requested to make sure that the experts involved to the committee are clear from vigilance angle.

BoG-XXIII (2019)-R9: The Board RESOLVED to APPROVE the list of experts proposed by the Institute.

<u>BoG- XXIII (2019)-10:</u> Recommendations of the XVII & XVIII Senate meeting of NIT Meghalaya held on 08.04.2019 and 30.05.2019 respectively at NIT Meghalaya.

The recommendations of the Senate of NIT Meghalaya in its XVII meeting held on 08.04.2019 as well as those of the XVIII meeting held on 30.05.2019 were placed before the Board. The Board deliberated the Minutes and resolved to approve them.
