<u>R2/BOG-IV/2013</u>: The Board **NOTED** the actions taken on the decisions in the 3rd meeting of the Board of Governors held on 29-06-2013 as reported. The Board also expressed its deep appreciation of the valuable service provided to the Institute by Sri C. D. Saio, outgoing member of the B&WC.

<u>Item No. 3</u> Amendments to the Statutes:- Raising of age of superannuation of Director from 65 to 70 years.

As per the decisions taken by the Council of NITs in its meeting on 28.06.2011 regarding raising the age limit of the Director of NITs to 70 years in line with that of the Directors of IITs and Vice-Chancellors of Central Universities a resolution is to be passed by the respective Boards of the NIT's before it can be put up for the consideration and approval of the Hon'ble Visitor. The matter was placed before the Board in its IInd meeting held on 23.03.2013 and vide resolution R3/BOG-II/2013 The Board RESOLVED to approve the proposal to raise the age limit of the Directors of NITs to 70 years and forward it to the Ministry of HRD for concurrence.

The Institute has now been informed by the ministry that The President as the Visitor to the National Institute of Technology(NITs) has been pleased to approve the proposal of the 10 new NITs for making amendments in the statutes of NITs relating revision in the age of superannuation of Director of NITs from 65 to 70 years, to bring it at par with the age of superannuation with the Directors of the Indian Institute of Technology(IITs), Director of 20 old National Institutes of Technology (NITs) and Vice-Chancellors of the Central Universities. It was necessary for the Board of Governors of NIT Meghalaya to adopt this change in the Statutes of NIT Meghalaya.

It was noted that as per Statute No. 5 of the First Statutes of all the NITs, the Board is empowered to make, modify or cancel the Statutes with the approval of the Visitor, from time to time.

<u>R3/BOG-IV/2013</u>: The Board **RESOLVED** to **ADOPT** the changes in the Statutes regarding raising of the age of superannuation of the Director from 65 to 70 years as described above.

<u>Item No. 4</u> Annual Report and Audited Accounts for the year 2012-13

As per provision of the Acts & Statutes, Annual Report of this Institute is to be prepared each year and is required to be sent to MHRD, Govt. of India for tabling before the Parliament.

The English version of the Draft Annual report for the year 2012-13 was placed

before the board for its approval. The Annual Accounts for the year 2012–13 which was adopted in the 3rd meeting of the board was forwarded to the Statutory Auditor and have already been audited by it. The Audit Certificate was awaited.

The Board was requested to consider and approve the Annual Report for the year 2012-13. The Board is further requested to authorize the Chairman of the Board to approve the annual accounts when the Audit Reports are received so that the Annual Report and the Audited Annual Accounts can be sent to the Ministry at the earliest possible.

The Board discussed the Draft Annual Report of the Institute for the year 2012-13 in detail and expressed its satisfaction on the progress made by the Institute during the year. Particular mention was made on the good number of publications made by the young faculty of the Institute.

R4/BOG-IV/2013: The Board RESOLVED to APPROVE the prepared Annual Report of the Institute for the Year 2012-13 with minor corrections to be sent to MHRD for tabling it in the parliament and to AUTHORISE the Chairman of the Board to approve the Annual Accounts to be sent to the Ministry for tabling it in the parliament once the Audit Certificate is received from the Statutory Auditor.

As per the proposal evaluation process mentioned in the tender document, Consultant Selection Committee while evaluating the Technical Proposals shall have no access to the Financial Proposals until the technical evaluation is concluded and competent authority accepts the recommendation.

The approval towards the acceptance of recommendation of the CSC for opening of financial bids of the two parties viz. RITES Limited and NPCC Ltd. by the B&WC of the Institute was taken by circulation.
