It is the cry of one whose childrens innocent dreams were ruthlessly shattered the agony of one whose old mother was humiliated and the anger of a citizen whose identity was publicly shredded. In the year 2023 when I and my family were expecting security and dignity of our lives in Government House No. 207 at Reserve Police Line Noida, the lock of our Government House was broken in an inhuman and illegal manner by some police officers and our personal belongings were thrown on the road. It was not just the lock of a house that was broken but it was the lock of the honour of Mother India that was broken it was a direct attack on the dignity honour pride and shaan of a citizen. The ideas of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel were insulted in which he had envisioned a strong and just nation where the dignity of every citizen is protected.
