In response to the RTI application NITMG/R/E/26/00005, the CPIO, NIT Meghalaya denied the requested information by quoting Section 8(1)(j). This is unsustainable for the following reasons:		
1.	<p>Violation of the Mandatory Provision to Section 8(1):</p> <p>The CPIO has completely ignored the mandatory Proviso to Section 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, which states:</p> <p>Provided that the information which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a State Legislature shall not be denied to any person.</p> <p>Since NIT Meghalaya is a Central Autonomous Body under the Ministry of Education, it is answerable to the Parliament. Therefore, under this Equality Proviso, the CPIO has no legal authority to deny this information to a citizen.</p>	<p>In reference to RTI Reg. No. (NITMG/R/E/26/00005) Kindly find attached documents as per Annexure I &amp; II</p>
2.	<p>Public Funding and the NITSER Act:</p> <p>The CPIOs own reference to the NITSER Act reinforces the Public nature of this information.</p> <p>Under Section 20 of the NITSER Act, the Institute receives Grants by the Central Government.</p> <p>Section 21(3) mandates that the The Fund of every Institute shall be applied towards meeting the expenses of the Institute including expenses incurred in the exercise of its powers and discharge of its duties under this Act</p> <p>Recruitment of staff (Section 24) and the subsequent payment of salaries is a discharge of these duties funded by the Public Exchequer. Consequently, any selection process for a post paid for by the public is a Public Activity and cannot be treated as a third-party matter.</p> <p>Additionally, Allahabad High Court on its judgement dated February 2026 had also ruled that Marks in public recruitment exams not confidential, can be disclosed under RTI Act without third party consent</p>	

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3.	<p>Overriding Effect of the RTI Act (Section 22):</p> <p>The CPIOs attempt to use the NITSER Act as a shield for denial of information is also logically flawed. Section 22 of the RTI Act contains a nonobstante clause that overrides any other law for the time being in force.</p> <p>Even if the NITSER Act or internal statutes contained such clauses that prevent disclosure of information, they are automatically overridden by the RTI Act.</p> <p>It is, therefore, requested that the information sought vide RTI application NITMG/R/E/26/00005 may be provided</p>
