

Furthermore, as per state and central government standards, Class 10 is recognized as a school level or matriculation level, not as a degree level. Given this, I am seeking detailed explanation as to why my applications are consistently rejected. I am fully qualified and eager to serve my country in a teaching profession. Kindly check on my detailed attached application and do let me know if other things are required from my side.	As per the Gazette of India Notification No.S.O.947(E) dated 21.07.2017 issued by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development (now renamed as Ministry of Education), Government of India, it is stated in Para(2) of Note 1 on Pg.14 as follows:- "All new entrants shall have PhD in the relevant or equivalent discipline and shall have first class in the preceding Degrees". In addition to the above, with regards to your application for faculty position in the Institute, information was received from the concerned Section that a relaxation of 5% for being a ST Candidate was given to you. However, even then your marks were inadequate.
