Law enforcement agencies have been taking various steps to address the growing presence of drugs in educational institutions and public places:

• Regular inspections: Schools, colleges, and public areas are frequently monitored by local police forces to detect and deter drug usage. Special anti-drug squads and

surveillance units have been set up to prevent drugs from entering educational institutions.

• Awareness programs: The government, in collaboration with non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and educational institutions, has initiated programs targeting youth to raise awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse and the importance of staying away from drugs.

• Counseling and support: School and college students who are identified as at-risk are provided with counseling and rehabilitation services to prevent the escalation of drug addiction.

• Collaboration with educational bodies: Efforts are underway to partner with educational institutions for regular workshops, seminars, and sensitization programs focusing on the risks associated with substance abuse.

D. How is the government ensuring strict enforcement of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, and what improvements are being made to prevent its misuse?

To ensure strict enforcement of the NDPS Act, the government has taken the following measures:

• Increased penalties: The Act has been amended multiple times to impose stricter penalties for drug-related offenses, including for both users and traffickers. This includes longer sentences and heavier fines.

• Specialized agencies: Dedicated agencies like the NCB and Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) work under the supervision of the Ministry of Home Affairs to enforce the NDPS Act

• Capacity building: Regular training and capacity building programs are conducted for law enforcement personnel to enhance their knowledge and skills in detecting and prosecuting drug-related crimes.

• Technology and surveillance: Modern surveillance techniques, such as satellite monitoring, electronic tracking, and data analytics, are employed to track the movement of drugs and apprehend traffickers.

• Preventive measures: Apart from punitive actions, preventive measures such as public awareness programs, rehabilitation, and the de-addiction process are being strengthened to address drug misuse and reduce demand.


