<u>BoG-XXVII (2021)-8:</u> Availing the facility of government accommodation from BSNL and other government Institutions.

It was informed to the Board that BSNL is having Type I - V quarters available for allocating to Central Government employees, employees of Autonomous Bodies and PSUs etc. The rate for each type of quarters has been finalized by BSNL. These quarters can be extended to the employees of NIT Meghalaya on request basis and after entering into an Agreement with BSNL by the concerned employees.

Since no accommodation has been provided by the Institute to the employees due to non-availability of accommodation and since operating from temporary campus, the proposal mentioned in the agenda was briefed to the Board members and the members agreed for the same for allowing the employees of the Institute to avail the quarters from BSNL and such other Central/State government Institutions/ Autonomous Bodies/PSUs etc.

It was also informed to the Board that the Finance Wing of the Institute shall deduct the rent for the quarters as per the prescribed rate of BSNL from the HRA/salary of the employees and pay the HRA directly to BSNL/ other Government Offices. In case the rent is more/less than the HRA, the excess/actual/less amount may be deducted from the employee's HRA/salary based on the undertaking given by the employee and send the rent amount directly to BSNL/ other Government Offices like lease accommodation. Therefore, the HRA or the amount as per the rent rate shall be directly paid to the said organizations instead of paying the same to the concern employees as HRA. In the instant case there is no financial implication to the Institute.

<u>BoG-XXVII (2021)-10</u>: Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and NIT Meghalaya

The Board was informed that a proposal regarding entering into a MoU with All Indian Council for Technical Education (AICTE) New Delhi, Government of India was received from Director (Faculty Development), AICTE, New Delhi vide email dated 02.11.2021. The MoU was required to be entered into for executing AICTE-NIT Meghalaya joint training programs for teachers of AICTE's approved Institutions of North-East Region. Accordingly, the MoU was prepared by the Institute and executed online on 01.12.2020 due to the national lockdown on account of the prevention of spread of COVID-19.
