Team: Sir, This time our Institute has been ranked 61st by the National Institute Ranking Framework, MHRD. What was your plan of action for this accomplishment?

Director: The rank of our Institute has ascended from 100th position in 2017 to 61st this year.

It is a great accomplishment with further scopes for improvement.

My current goal is to secure the position of our institute within the top 50 engineering Institutes. It was only with the help and cooperation of all the faculty members, staffs and our hardworking students that we have achieved this feat. Placement sector is

performing better, results have improved, and these are contributing factors to a better rank. As NITM is operating from a temporary campus, we have some space constraints, but these impediments have not come in our way in excelling in academic sphere, we have good number of projects involving both faculties and students. If we could shift to our permanent campus in another half a year, we can conduct numerous additional activities that will eventually lead to an improved rank. There is always a continuous effort to make our Institute visible to outsiders through regular activities (student activities, faculty activities). Among the 32 NITs, this time, we are at 15th position, which means we have surpassed many well established old national level institutes. It encourages us immensely to work harder.
