integrity of the candidates. The detailed instructions and steps for appearing for the Main Examination will be shared on the Institute website soon.

For appearing in the Stage -II Main Examinations through Auto Proctor portal, the candidates are required to have an electronic device (desktop PC, laptop, tab, mobile phone, etc.) which has internet connectivity and integrated active facilities of webcam and microphone. **CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR THE EXAMINATION THROUGH A DEVICE WITHOUT EITHER A WEBCAM OR A MICROPHONE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ENTER INTO THE GOOGLE CLASSROOM FOR THE EXAMINATION.**

Those candidates who are not able to arrange for an electronic device (desktop PC, laptop, tab, mobile phone, etc.) with integrated facilities of webcam and microphone may opt for appearing in the examination in person in the campus of NIT Meghalaya at Bijni Complex, Laitumkhrah, Shillong 793003. Such candidates shall give their option by writing an email to the Helpdesk at the email [staff_recruitment\[at\]nitm.ac.in](mailto:staff_recruitment@nitm.ac.in) by 31.10.2021.

Such candidates will have to make their own arrangements to comply with the COVID-19 entry protocols notified by the Govt. of Meghalaya. The latest notification dated 6th September, 2021 is enclosed herewith for reference. No TA/DA will be admissible for these candidates for appearing in the examination at NIT Meghalaya. The candidates will also have to make their own arrangement for lodging and food.

Such candidates will appear for the examination online through the Google Classroom platform, but without Auto Proctor, in the Computer Centre/ Labs of the Institute with faculty/staff as invigilators.

Candidates who have applied for the different posts in more than one Department(s) and have passed the Preliminary Test will have to appear for the Stage-II Main Examinations separately for the different posts of all Departments / Centres they have applied for. Such candidates will have to ensure that they have been invited and have accepted the invitation to the Google Classrooms of all the posts they have applied for. In case of any query or discrepancy, the candidates are advised to email immediately to the Helpdesk at the email [staff_recruitment\[at\]nitm.ac.in](mailto:staff_recruitment@nitm.ac.in).

No separate call letter for the Stage-II Main Examinations will be issued to the candidates. Receipt of invitations to all the Google Classrooms for the different posts of all Departments/ Centres shall be considered as the call for appearing in the Stage-II Main Examinations.

The Stage-II Main Examinations will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions. The candidates will have to answer 60 (sixty) questions in 60 (sixty) minutes. Correct answers will be awarded 3 (three) marks. There will be 1 (one) negative mark for every wrong answer. Unanswered questions will not be given any marks, i.e. Zero mark.
