This is for information of all concerned that based on the performance in the Mains Examination for the posts of Technical Assistant, Dept. of Chemistry (TA-CY) and Technician, which were conducted on 11.11.2021 through online mode (Google Classroom and Auto Proctor) and with the approval of the Competent Authority, the lists of candidates shortlisted to appear for the Stage-III Skill/ Trade Tests are available in the links below. The complete results and marks obtained by candidates who were shortlisted for the Stage-II Mains Examination for the various posts are also available below.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. The Stage-III Skill/ Trade Test for the post of Technical Assistant, Dept. of Chemistry (TA-CY) will be held on the 25th November, 2021 in the Dept. of Chemistry, NIT Meghalaya, Bijni Complex, Laitumkhrach, Shillong 793003.
2. The Stage-III Skill/ Trade Test for all posts of Technician will be held on the 26th November, 2021 in the concerned Department/ Centre, NIT Meghalaya, Bijni Complex, Laitumkhrach, Shillong 793003.
3. The candidates must first report at the Lecture Hall, NIT Meghalaya, Bijni Complex, Laitumkhrach, Shillong 793003 at 09:30 AM for verification of their documents.
4. After document verification, the candidates shall proceed to the concerned Departments/ Centres for the Skill/ Trade Test.
5. The Tests shall tentatively commence from 10:00 AM onwards.
6. You are required to bring with you, the following documents for verification/ submission:
 - a) A valid Identity Card (Voter's ID card (EPIC) / Driver's License / Aadhar Card/ PAN card/ Passport / or any other Government issued ID card) as proof of identity.
 - b) All certificates /proof of date of birth/caste certificate/experience certificate, etc. and mark-sheets, in original, commencing from High School (i.e., class 10th).
 - c) Proof that you belong to Schedule Caste (SC), Schedule Tribe (ST) and OBC category, if claimed by you; OBC candidates shortlisted for Stage-III Skill/ Trade Test must produce the latest OBC certificate which should not be older than 6 months from the date of the Test. Candidates failing to produce the certificate as instructed will be summarily rejected and will not be allowed to appear for the Test.
 - d) If you are in service with any Government Organisation/ Autonomous Bodies/ Corporation/ Statutory Bodies, etc, "No Objection Certificate" (NOC), from your

- present employer (or a copy of the forwarding letter in case your application was duly forwarded through proper channel) is required. Document in support/proof of experience and salary drawn.
- e) The candidate should also bring along with him/her a complete set of self-attested photocopies of the above documents.
 - f) Candidates not producing the original certificates or providing false certificates shall not be permitted for the Stage-III Skill/ Trade Test.
7. Please note that your candidature is purely provisional and subject to a verification check of your credentials from your original records which will include the Institute confirming that you meet the essential scrutiny conditions of age, qualification, and minimum experience, etc., as prescribed in the advertisement.
 8. Being shortlisted for appearing in Stage-III Skill/ Trade Test does not entitle the candidate to be considered for appearing in the recruitment process unless he/she fulfils the minimum scrutiny conditions. **APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED IN THE ADVERTISEMENT BEFORE APPEARING IN THE STAGE-III SKILL/ TRADE TEST.** If an applicant is inadvertently allowed to appear for the Test who otherwise does not fulfil the minimum scrutiny requirements, he/she cannot, at a later date, use that as a right to claim that he/she meets the requirements.
 9. The Institute reserves the right not to allow a candidate to appear for the Test if it is found that:
 - (a) Minimum requirements are not fulfilled.
 - (b) False documentation has been presented.
 - (c) Any other similar valid reasons.
 10. No request for any change in date/time of reporting for the Test will be entertained.
 11. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the Test. Candidates will also have to make their own arrangements for lodging and food.
