In this connection, this is to inform that Implementation for the provisions of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Teacher's Cadre) Act, 2019 in Central funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) was adopted by the Board of Governors (BoG) of the Institute in its XXVth Meeting held on the 09.12.2019 vide Resolution No.: BoG/XXV/2019-11.

However, the suggestions made by the JS&FA for smooth and uniform implementation of the CEIs Act 2019(Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) in CFTIs vide O.M.F.No.15-4/2020-TC dated 10.02.2021 may be difficult to implement in NIT Meghalaya due to the following reasons: -

- Para 3(2) of letter F. No. 33-3/2018-TS.III dated 5th November 2019 issued by the Ministry of Education states that "for the purpose of reservation of posts, a Central Educational Institution shall be regarded as one unit".
- 2. Para 6 of letter F. No. 33-3/2018-TS.III dated 5th November 2019 issued by the Ministry of Education states that "as per provisions under the Act, the Institutes are required to maintain their rosters according to the strength of the teachers' cadre. The NITs/IIEST while continuing with the prevailing flexible faculty structure, shall provide for the reservation of posts in appointments by direct recruitment", which is currently being followed by NIT Meghalaya for the 78 Sanctioned Faculty posts.
- 3. The 78 Sanctioned Faculty Posts allotted to the Institute by the Ministry were not segregated out as Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors (Grade I), Assistant Professors (Grade II) Level 11 and Assistant Professors (Grade II) Level 10.
- 4. The Institute follows the 4- Tier Flexible Faculty Structure as directed by the Ministry vide letter F.No.33-9/2011-TS.III dated 30.11.2017 whereby a formula is provided for computing the "normal faculty strength" in any department. The distribution of faculty positions among the departments will be flexible to dynamically maximize the number of faculty in position at any given time.
